CLARK COUNTY PROBATE COURT CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK FOR ADOPTION INFORMATION AND CONSENT

Under the provisions of Senate Bill 38, the agency completing the assessment is required to have the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCII) conduct a criminal records check on individuals who are prospective adoptive parents. If the records check results indicate a disqualifying condition as prescribed by 5101.2-33-52 of the Administrative Code, the individual may be denied consideration as an adoptive parent.

The information reported by BCII is not a public record and will not be made available to anyone other than the appropriate Department of Human Services representative.
